Description of Incident	Incurred Claim
Driver fell asleep at the wheel, struck and killed two people who were changing a tire on the roadside	\$949,521
Vehicle operator made left hand turn in front of other vehicle	\$1,500,000
Driver hit other vehicle carrying 3 passengers. One 14 year old girl sustained brain stem injury	\$518,644
16 year old son traveling at excessive speed hit other vehicle, killing both occupants	\$2,900,000
Injured party cutting homeowner's lawn, cut electrical cord and was electrocuted	\$750,000
Guest dove in shallow water and became a Quadriplegic	\$959,000
27 year old passenger, had legs dangling over bow of boat owned (50%) and driven by co-owner. At 11:00 PM the boat hit a buoy resulting in a severed right leg and subsequent amputation of left leg	\$1,003,273
Son at college hosted a fraternity party. An intoxicated participant caused an auto accident	\$1,125,000
Homeowner's children shooting a pellet gun in their backyard when a stray shot went through neighbor's window and injured neighbor's eye	\$6,000,000
16 year old suffered quadriplegia when he dove off homeowner's roof into swimming pool. Homeowner was not home and supervising adult had been drinking	\$500,000
A 78 year old female was allegedly knocked down by the homeowner's tenant's dog and suffered hip fracture	\$350,000
25 year older passenger in power boat was severely injured when the boat struck a beam separating two canals	\$1,500,000
